COMMISSIONER'S ORDER NO.04 /2013

Whereas Joint Secretary to Government of Odisha, Food Supplies and Consumer Welfare Deptt., Bhubaneswar has requested for relaxation of restrictions on movement of perishable goods like Onion and Vegetables of Kuberpuri Merchant Association, Bhubaneswar goods carriers in Jatni Town limit (Pittapalli) to travel to Aiginia, Bhubaneswar on NH-5 during the restricted hours i.e. 08.00 AM to 12.00 Noon and 4.00 PM to 8.00 PM vide Commissioner's Order No.9/2010. The distance of Aiginia Vegetables Godown from Pittapalli diversion is about 8 KMs towards Bhubaneswar. Movement of these loaded truck shall not create any traffic congestion and traffic hazards for the Bhubaneswar city on NH-5 as reported by DCP, Bhubaneswar.

With a view to facilitate smooth distribution system of essential commodities like Onion and Vegetables in the larger public interest and by virtue of powers conferred u/s 28 of the Odisha Urban Police Act 2003 (Odisha Act 8 of 2007 and in pursuance of Regulation 34(i) of Bhubaneswar-Cuttack Police Commissionerate (Traffic and Public Order) Regulation, 2008, it is hereby ordered that the vegetables/union goods carriers of Kuberpuri Merchant Association bearing appropriate banner in respect of the same shall be allowed to ply from Pittapalli junction (Jatni town limit) to Aiginia, Bhubaneswar during the restricted hours i.e. 8.00 AM to 12.00 Noon and 4.00 PM to 8.00 PM temporarily till further order for the interest of public.
