

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

DCP, Cuttack has proposed vide his letter No.1327/DIB dt.06.4.2015 basing on the request received from ACP, Traffic, Cuttack vide his letter No.244/ACP-Tr dt.01.4.15 to restrict plying of heavy vehicles (6 or more wheelers trucks) on N.H-5 under Cuttack city limit between 8 AM to 11 AM and 5 PM to 9 PM. in view of construction of fly over bridge (Khapuria) as well as execution of road expansion work at Press Chhak, Madhupatna chhak, Samrat Cinema chhak and LHS side of Taladanda canal bridge at Kalyani nagar, OMP square and Under- pass at Manimandira chhak at a time. In the last TMC meeting held on 20.3.2015, NHAI authorities have assured to complete the above construction work by 15.6.2015 in view of ensuing Nabakalebara in July 2015. In order to avoid traffic congestion during peak hours between Press Chhak to OMP chhak due to flow of heavy vehicular traffic, following traffic movement is restricted for smooth flow of vehicular traffic till completion of the construction of above project works before Nabakalebar in the larger interest of general public.

Therefore by virtue of powers conferred u/s 28 of Odisha Urban Police Act 2003 (Odisha Act 8 of 2007) and in pursuance of Regulation 36 of Bhubaneswar - Cuttack Police Commissionerate (Traffic and Public Order) Regulations 2008, it is hereby notified that goods carrier or heavy trucks (6 wheeler and more) coming from Pitapalli side intending to go to Cuttack side via Balikuda shall be stopped at Sitaram Bazar under Barang P.S between 8 AM to 11 AM and 5 PM to 9 PM. Similarly goods carrier or heavy trucks (6 wheeler and more) coming from Manguli and Salipur side intending to go towards Bhubaneswar side via Cuttack shall be stopped at Jagatpur Golei chhak between 8 AM to 11 AM and 5 PM to 9 PM with immediate effect till 15.6.2015. However Goods vehicle carrying essential commodities are exempted from the restriction.

Violation of the instant order is an offence punishable u/s 96 of the Odisha Urban Police Act 2003 and is compoundable by an officer of and above the rank of Inspector of Police with a minimum fine of Rs.500/- which can extend up to Rs.1000/-.

- 7) Copy to I.Is.C, Barang P.S/ Jagatpur P.S/ Sadar P.S/ Jatni P.S for information and necessary action.
