PUBLIC NOTICE

DCP, Cuttack has proposed vide his letter No.1782/DIB dt.13.5.2015 basing on the request received from ACP, Traffic, Cuttack vide his letter No.355/ACP-Tr dt.12.5.15 for restriction of plying of heavy vehicles (6 or more wheelers trucks) and passenger buses from OMP square to Kandarpur via Nuabazar and Biribati chhak and vice versa on 15.5.2015 and 16.5.2015 from 7 AM till passing of Divine Daru of Lord Shri Jagannath up to Balikuda chhak for smooth darshan of devotees at Bidyadharpur Sai Temple, Cuttack.

Therefore by virtue of powers conferred u/s 28 of Odisha Urban Police Act 2003 (Odisha Act 8 of 2007) and in pursuance of Regulation 36 of Bhubaneswar - Cuttack Police Commissionerate (Traffic and Public Order) Regulations 2008, it is therefore notified that the following traffic diversion/ restriction as suggested by ACP, Traffic, Cuttack for plying of goods carrier/ heavy trucks(6 wheelers or more) and passenger buses shall be undertaken as follows:-


(1) All goods carrier or heavy vehicles (6 or more wheelers trucks) and passenger buses are hereby restricted for plying from OMP square to Kandarpur via Nuabazar and Biribati chhak and vice versa on 15.5.2015 and 16.5.2015 from 7 AM till passing of Divine Daru of Lord Shri Jagannath up to Balikuda chhak in order to avoid traffic congestion and L/O problem in view of following many Sankirtan/ Ghantua group and gathering of large number of devotees for the purpose of darshan at Siridi Sai Temple, Bidyadharpur.

(2) All goods carrier or heavy vehicles (6 or more wheelers trucks) and passenger buses coming from Cuttack side intending to go to Paradeep and Jagatsinghpur shall be diverted at OMP square to proceed to Manguli chhak on 15.5.2015 and 16.5.2015 from 7 AM till passing of Divine Daru of Lord Shri Jagannath.

(3) Similarly the aforesaid categories of vehicles coming from Paradeep and Jagatsinghpur side intending to go to Cuttack side shall be restricted at Kandarpur on 15.5.2015 and 16.5.2015 from 7 AM till passing of Divine Daru of Lord Shri Jagannath.

However goods vehicle carrying essential commodities and vehicles on emergency duty will be exempted from the restriction.

Violation of the instant order is an offence punishable u/s 96 of the Odisha Urban Police Act 2003 and is compoundable by an officer of and above the rank of Inspector of Police with a minimum fine of Rs.500/- which can extend up to Rs.1000/-.
