**PUBLIC NOTICE**


On the basis of the recommendation of 40<sup>th</sup> Traffic Management Committee meeting held on 16.9.2014, DCP, Cuttack vide his letter No.3931/DIB dt.22.9.2014 has proposed to impose restriction on plying of heavy goods vehicles (6 wheelers and more) on N.H-5 from 9.00 AM to 11.00 PM during Dassehra festival from 30.9.2014 to 05.10.2014 in order to avoid traffic congestion on N.H-5 from Press Chhak to OMP square as construction of Taladanda Fly Over bridge near Samrat Cinema hall on N.H-5 is going on by NHAI.

In partial modification of Public Notice dt.17.2.2014 issued to all concerned vide Memo No.87/CP-Tr. Dt.17.2.2014 and by virtue of powers conferred u/s 28 of Odisha Urban Police Act 2003 (Odisha Act 8 of 2007) and in pursuance Regulation 36 of Bhubaneswar - Cuttack Police Commissionerate (Traffic and Public Order) Regulations 2008, it is hereby ordered that heavy goods vehicles (6 wheelers and more) coming from Khurda side (Pitapalli) shall not be allowed to ply temporarily in to Commissionerate area from 9.00 AM to 11 PM to avoid traffic congestion from Press chhak to OMP square under Cuttack city limit during Dussehra festival except goods carrier carrying essential commodities.

In the background of the above, public notice issued to this effect vide this office Memo No.86/CP-Tr. Dt.17.2.2014 is hereby revoked temporarily:

It is hereby notified that after completion of Durga puja festival from 30.9.2014 to 05.10.2014, the public notice issued for this purpose will be automatically cancelled and public notice issued vide Memo No.87/CP-Traffic dt.17.2.14 shall remain in force in supersession of all public orders.

Violation of the instant order is an offence punishable u/s 96 of the Odisha Urban Police Act,2003 and is compoundable by an officer of and above the rank of Inspector of Police with a minimum fine of Rs.500/- which can extend up to Rs.1000/-
